

Mirjam Künkler [kuenkler@princeton.edu] received her Ph.D. from Columbia University, NY, and is assistant professor in Near Eastern studies at Princeton University, NJ. She has published on religion-state relations and Islamic thought in 20th century Iran and Indonesia, and edited with Alfred Stepan, *Indonesia, Islam and Democracy*, Columbia University Press (2013), and with John Madeley and Shylashri Shankar, *A Secular Age: Beyond the West*, (2014). Dr. Künkler has guest-edited special issues for the *Journal of Law and Religion* (Vol. 28, 2, 2013), the journal *Party Politics* (March 2013) and *Modern Asian Studies* (Spring 2014); other articles have appeared or are forthcoming in the journals *Comparative Studies of Society and History*, *Journal of the Royal Asiatic Society*, *Democratization* and the *Journal of International Affairs*. In her next project, she turns to the post-revolutionary transformation of the legal system in the Islamic Republic of Iran, and questions about female religious authority in *Shi'i* Islam. She is a senior research fellow at KITLV (Leiden, NL), and co-PI of the *Iran Social Science Data Portal* (www.princeton.edu/irandataportal).
